REMINDER: If you received a MPB Gift Certificate for Christmas, you have until Feb. 29 to cash it in for SCRIP.

Our fiscal year ends Feb. 29, so now's the time to pump up your profits!

1. If you have your profits assigned to another family, make sure that family is a regular SCRIP participant. If they aren't, we will ask you to assign your profits to another family or church utilities.
2. If you receive a receipt when purchasing SCRIP, please note: The "Contribution" column reflects total profit. Divide that in half to determine your tuition profit.
3. **8th Grade Parents:** Is your child attending Luers or Dwenger? Make sure we know your choice by Feb. 29th.
4. **12th Grade Parents:** You can assign your profits to a college! You **MUST** let us know by Feb. 29 if you want that option. You don't have to know which college at this point.
