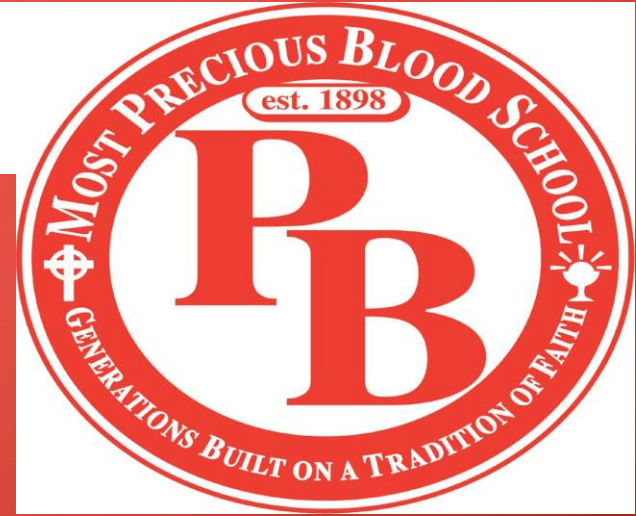

# WHAT IS A CHROMEBOOK?



## GOALS:

- The school learning environment will improve by supporting, teaching, and learning with 21<sup>st</sup> Century Tools.
- Communication among parents, teachers, and students will increase through the use of Chromebooks.
- Teachers will implement adaptable and flexible teaching and learning strategies.
- Students will have access to Chromebook devices for use in their classes and at home.

# MOST PRECIOUS BLOOD ACCEPTABLE USE HIGHLIGHTS

- Follow all diocesan, state, and federal regulations regarding internet usage.
- Video record and photograph only approved content.
- Use Canvas and other communication responsibly.
- Keep your account information private.
- School administrators may review files to ensure students are using technology that is consistent with the acceptable use policies.

# STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Treat the Chromebook with care by not dropping it, getting it wet, leaving it outdoors, or using it with food and drink nearby.
- Do not lend your Chromebook to anyone - not even friends or siblings.
- Do not attempt to load or remove any apps onto the Chromebook.
- Do not give out personal information.
- Bring your Chromebook fully-charged to school everyday.
- Only clean the Chromebook with a soft cloth, no liquid.

# CONSEQUENCES

- What happens when students don't have their Chromebook at school?
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Offense – Warning issued
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense – Minor Referral
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense – Major Referral, students will create a plan to avoid this problem in the future.
- Each time a parent will be called to deliver the Chromebook and the student will use paper or an alternative until the Chromebook arrives. If assignment must be completed with the Chromebook, it will be counted as a late assignment.

# PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supervise your child's use of the Chromebook at home.
- Discuss your expectations regarding the use of the Internet at home and supervise its use.
- Do not attempt to clean the Chromebook with anything other than a soft, dry cloth.
- Report any problems with the Chromebook.
- Do not attempt to load or delete any software from the Chromebook.
- Make sure your child charges the Chromebook each night and brings it to school every day.

# YOU ARE IN CHARGE AT HOME.

- Make a plan for you will manage the technology at home.
- Ideas include:
  - Create a scheduled time for working on the device.
  - Designate a place in your home for working online.
  - Choose a place to charge the device overnight so that your child can remember it in the morning.
- We know many of your students have access to the Internet from their phones or at home, and you are already working with them to be safe online. We want to continue to partner with you to teach your child to use the Internet responsibly and efficiently.
