On September 19 we have to submit a form to the CSO so they can plan seating arrangements and parking. If we do get enough drivers for a class then that class will not be able attend.

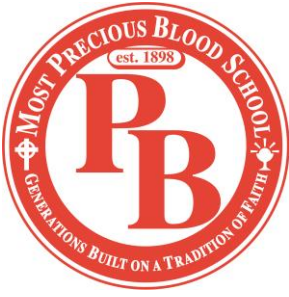
The Mass is a wonderful opportunity for our students to worship with thousands of Catholic School Students.

Classes will start the first week in October.

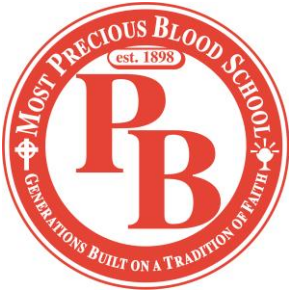

12:15-1:45 – 7<sup>th</sup>-grade - students together - Beginnings of Life (90 min)

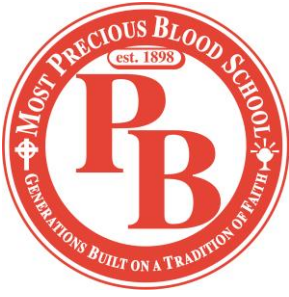
1:55 – 2:40 – 6th-grade boys only - Just for Boys (45 min)
