## **Program description**

Super Shot provides immunizations against flu and over 15 other vaccine preventable childhood diseases to children ages birth to 18 who are uninsured, under-insured, or Medicaid eligible. Our largest program is our network of 4 immunization clinic sites in Fort Wayne and surrounding communities. We also reach children through Project Immunize (for children from birth to age two); Reminder Recall (personal and autodialed calls and postcards when a child is due or past due for shots); and Community Education including distribution of educational materials to parents of newborns at local hospitals, child care facilities, community partners and at our clinic sites.

# What you should know before visiting Super Shot

- We are a walk-in clinic. First come, first served.
- Children must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- We serve Medicaid, uninsured and under-insured children from birth through 18 years old.
- We serve uninsured and under-insured adults.
- There is a \$10 fee per shot: Medicaid is accepted.
- No one will be turned away due to inability to pay.

# What you should know before visiting a Super Shot clinic:

Super Shot is a walk in clinic, no appointment is necessary, everyone will be seen on a first come first serve basis. Everyone must bring a current shot record to every visit. There is a \$10 fee per shot. No one will be turned away for failure to pay.

### Children (under 18):

- We serve Medicaid, uninsured and underinsured children from birth thru 18 years of age
- All children, under the age of 18, must be accompanied by parent or legal guardian
- All CDC recommended vaccinations for children are available
- Must bring a copy of the child's shot record.

### Adults (18+):

- We also serve those underinsured and uninsured adults by offering a limited number of vaccinations, including: Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, Human papillomavirus (HPV), Influenza, Varicella, Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis (Tdap), Measles, mumps, rubella (MMR), Meningococcal, Pneumococcal 13 valent conjugate (PCV13), and Pneumococcal polysaccharide (PSV23) vaccines
- Bring a copy of your shot record.
