The Most Precious Blood development committee had vision of bringing to together a representative of every school committee and posing the following strategic planning questions:

1. What are your funding needs for this school year?
2. What are your long-term funding needs?
3. What are your short and long-term improvement items? Looking to the future, what do we want to be able to do for the school and students?

Each committee prepared a report and came together for a collaborative meeting. The committee representatives have collaboratively created a strategic facility improvement plan and timeline.



Father Joe has earmarked all of the Bishop's Appeal overage to go to the top priorities of the plan. Our top priority is updating all of the school restrooms, including Mohr Hall, and making the gym restroom handicap accessible. Improvements will include all new stalls and hardware (current stalls and toilet paper holders are rusting away), paint and improved lighting. Additional priority items include installing barriers in the balcony and stairwells (safety improvement); replacing all ceiling tiles (improve air quality); and updating the north gym entrance; and teachers' lounge.

If the Bishop's appeal can generate a total of \$95,000.00, we will be able to complete the entire priority list of projects. If each parish family can pledge \$550.00 (\$45.83 / month), we will meet our goal. The renovations and improvements will help instill an updated and secure learning environment for generations to come. We are educating tomorrow's leaders of our Parish and community.
